About Us

Society for Action in Community Health (SACH) has come a long way since it was founded 1988 by a group of medical professionals. Initially focused on policy advocacy to improve the access of the urban poor to public health services in India, the organisation over the years grew to become one of the pioneering models for sustainable interventions in the area of policy and program formulation in health sector.

Some of the major inventions during this period included Geriatrics Center set up in Pitampura, New Delhi with the help of HelpAge India, and the collaboration with Project Hope, USA in 2008, to train over 4000 Diabetes Educators under flagship India Diabetes Educator Program (IDEP) by partnering with leading endocrinologists, researchers and medical education institutions in Delhi, Kolkata, Indore, Pune, Vellore and Bangalore.

But in the past one decade, SACH sought to expand beyond the health issues related to urban poor and engaged in other activities with new emerging new challenges. In 2015, SACH joined hands with HDFC and successfully implemented School Restoration Project in 14 schools which were devastated by 2014 floods and constructed/renovated around 300 sanitation units in Meghalaya and Punjab. SACH launched Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) program in the same regions and schools where these sanitation units were constructed.

Simultaneously, SACH started a Meal Packaging Programme with Broadcom and implementing partner Stop Hunger Now (SHN) to address the poverty conditions like hunger and malnutrition in Bengaluru. SACH managed to reach out to the people living in rural areas by providing them access to health care through Mobile Medical Units in Banka and Prakasam districts of Bihar and Andhra Pradesh respectively.

SACH effectively intervened in urban governance through a project for Sustainable Development for Ganga- Yamuna River ecosystems in Allahabad Region in 2016, with support from Global Green. Earlier, SACH partnered with Global Green Fund in 2014 to help deprived communities access right to water and sanitation, water for drinking and domestic needs and sanitation and solid waste management in selected slum areas in Delhi. SACH also spread awareness about sanitation and hygiene with GIZ. SACH conducted a study during 2012-13) to delve into the causes of pollution to river Ganges in the city of Kanpur with India Water Partnership (IWP) and Society for Promotion of Wasteland Development (SPWD) Delhi.

As for future initiatives, SACH will be focusing on village development project in Punjab and Meghalaya and on promoting a multi-state cooperative of health workers.

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan/ Environment/ Water & Sanitation



Construction of toilets in Punjab and Meghalaya

Government's major focus on Cooperate Social Responsibility (CSR) and the improvement of school sanitation facilities provided an opportunity to SACH to make major intervention on this front in Meghalaya and Punjab.

If we talk specifically about Meghalaya, it is among the top five states in India, where school sanitation facilities can be termed as poor. Despite the best efforts of the state government, the specific geographical, financial and other constraints have posed a great challenge to the government to provide adequate sanitation facilities to the schools. As per a report by the Department of School Education and Literacy (DISE), Union Ministry of Human Resource Development, 94% schools in the state either don't have toilets or they are dysfunctional. The situation in Punjab is no better.

Under the Hon Prime Minister's Swachha Bharat Mission, SACH joined hands with HDFC Bank to construct 167 sanitation facilities under School Sanitation Project (SSP) in 136 public schools in Meghalaya which include those under Department of Education, Govt of Meghalaya and under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan). The initiative has covered 88 villages from four districts. They are- East Khasi Hills (8 schools from 7 villages), Ri Bhoi (36 schools), Jaintia Hills (Undivided) (54 schools) and West Khasi Hills (38 schools).

In Punjab, 157 sanitations in 118 schools were constructed in 10 districts. They are- Amritsar, Ludhiana, Ropar, Fategarh Sahib, Moga, Firozpur, Fazilka, Kapurthala, Tarantaran, and Gurdaspur.





WASH Programme

It is estimated that 88% of diarrheal disease is caused by unsafe water supply, and inadequate sanitation and hygiene. Many schools serve communities that have a high prevalence of diseases related to inadequate water supply, sanitation and hygiene, and where child malnutrition and other underlying health problems are common.

SACH believes that schools provide excellent opportunities to support sanitation and hygiene promotion programs. Keeping this in mind SACH with support from HDFC Bank launched Water, Sanitation and Hygiene programme (WASH) to improve health through better sanitation and hygiene. Construction and use of appropriate child friendly sanitary facilities (handwashing stations, soap and toilets) can be especially effective in reducing the incidence of diarrhea and other water borne diseases.

Schools may be better locations to enforce certain behaviors in children than the home. Schools can also provide an arena where sanitation can be showcased at its best, and certain positive hygienic behaviors (hand washing with soap before eating and after going to the toilet) can become an engrained habit at a young age.

Nevertheless, hygiene promotion in school cannot rely solely on teaching and enforcing certain habits. Research has shown that children will more willingly change behavior if they are having fun and if they are following their peers. Imitation is one of the most successful forms of learning; hence young children will look to their older brothers and sisters or to older school friends to adopt new behaviors and life skills.

- Students Can Keep School Premises Neat and Clean By
- Involvement of Local Community
- How to keep water sources/wells/ septic tanks clean
- The Water Borne Diseases

Restoration of Schools



The unprecedented floods in Jammu and Kashmir in 2014 threw lives of millions out of gear. It not only devastated the state's infrastructures, but also severely affected health services and educational institutions. As per government estimates, more than 2500 schools buildings in the state were affected by the floods. The scale of damage to school buildings was such that majority of them faced closure at the time of floods and are still holding classes in dilapidated buildings.

As part of response to this calamity, SACH through its CSR initiative with HDFC Bank LTD. restored/ improved the conditions of 13 schools in Kashmir region. As a result of this these which were on the verge of closing down, have become functional again.

SACH carried the following activities on this front.

- Restored school buildings and infrastructure.
- Constructed of sanitation facilities- Urinals/toilets for girls and boys: The sanitation facilities were fully damaged by the floods. These were rebuilt.
- Provided furniture and fixtures: Tables, Chairs, lights and fans, water purifiers and water coolers & whiteboards were provided to all schools.
- Set up science Lab and the existing lab facilities were upgraded.
- Set up computer labs and libraries.
- Provided school uniforms and text books for economically weaker sections for this academic year as the parents of these children have lost their livelihoods due to flooding of the farm land and thus face difficulties in playground.



Active Ageing / Care of the aged

Geriatrics Care

The need to have a comprehensive policy for the elderly and active ageing has yet to find its due recognition in country's social and public health system. Despite technological advances in the health care, very few institutes can boast of providing all the facilities under one roof that the elderly need. Geriatric Research and Training Centre (GRTC) set up in New Delhi's Pitampura area seeks to address the health care needs of the elderly to make their life active by providing aids/ facilities they need.

With the focus on active aging, GRTC is perhaps the only dedicated in Delhi for the exclusive care and services for the elderly. The services at center are integrated to take care of all needs of the elderly. It seeks to address chronic care requirements of the elderly like those suffering from Alzheimer related dementia stroke, paralysis, joint pain, disc pain, spondylitis, obesity, etc. The center also has dental and eye OPDs. The treatment offered here is aimed at improving life style and promoting optimism and hope.

GRTC is equipped with state-of-the-art geriatric physiotherapy department, dedicated Ayurveda team. The Centre also has a well-designed and looked after Day Centre for those elderly who want to spend day time in the company of other elderly. It has a library, recreation room, TV, internet café and mess.

The center was started with seed grant provided by HelpAge India, a leading national charity. Later it got additional support from Asian Paints.

Most of our patients who visit are poor but can afford a treatment a nominal cost. Though this is not sufficient to cover all costs, efforts are afoot to make it sustainable in near future. The average treatment time for a patient is 2-3 hrs every day. The Center is attracting 30-40 patients daily.

The center offers treatment for the following:

- Alzheimer related dementia stroke
- Paralysis
- Joint pain
- Disc pain
- Spondylitis
- Obesity



Day Care services for Dementia and Stroke

GRTC is fully functional as a Day Care Centre for the Alzheimer related dementia affected persons. It conducts dementia screening camps periodically, and provides follow-up treatments to patients. These services carefully planned and ensure that all care and treatment needs are offered with minimum stress and inconvenience to the patients. It also houses equipped Pathology Laboratory caters for routine pathological tests.

Day Care Centre offers a lively and conducive environment for treatment of dementia and stroke, paralysis affected persons. Day Centre is designed to promote well-being through social and health-related services. Nutritious meals include special diets afternoon snacks. Trained neuro physiotherapists, caregivers and other health professionals provide physical, occupational, dental and speech therapy. They are supported by specialists' visit at least twice a month to assess the progress milestone and redefine treatment plan and care services accordingly.

Day Care Services/ Treatment: The Center provides daily treatment, rest, food and snacks to the patients and offers space and entertainment facilities such as TV, games like chess, caroms, cards, and meditation. Other treatment services provided are specialist consultations, rejuvenation care, and homeopathy.

With the support of HelpAge India and Asian Paints, the Alzheimer and Dementia care Services were started in October 2014. The first month the Center had 11 patients and in subsequent months the number increased. The number of Day Care patients touched 45 by February 2015.

The center offers the following services

- Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Services
- Eye Care O.P.D
- Speech Therapy
- Homeopathy Clinic
- Dental Clinic
- Basic Pathology Laboratory
- Kerala Ayurveda Therapy
- Transportation Services





Care Giver Training

In the coming years India might witness growing number of elderly persons accelerating the demand for care giving. With families becoming increasingly nucleus and smaller formal or family caregiving cannot be sustained in future and it will be difficult to find family members for caregiving except the living spouse. With families becoming smaller and jobs becoming increasingly demanding, more and more people prefer leaving their ailing parents or relatives to the care of a formal caregiver. SACH decided to play pioneering role to address this issues and held number of training programmes.

In June 2015, SACH collaborated with National Institute of Social Defence, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government. of India to two- month certificate course in geriatric care for bedside assistance/caretaker. The course in which 40 persons enrolled included lecture, internal assessments, assignments, survey of 50 aged people to understand their basic needs and required care, hospital and placement in geriatric institutions/hospitals.

Before that a training programme was held in Bhopal in geriatric care giving from 16 December 2013 to 21 January 2014. It was Skill development training & Certification Programme in which 40 people received training.



Nutrition Support

SACH partnered with IT giant Broadcom to support distribution of food and other lifesaving aid to children and families in Bengaluru under Meal Packaging Programme. The project, being carried out as per new CSR guidelines, intends to help them get out of the acute poverty conditions like hunger and malnutrition. The major targeted interventions through this programme are education, health and residential care projects. The project is being implemented through Stop Hunger Now (SHN) India.



Stop Hunger Now India packages highly nutritious dry uncooked meals comprised of rice, dal, dehydrated vegetables and a flavoring mix of 23 essential vitamins and minerals. Each packet provides a reasonable serving for six and is easy to transport, store and distribute to those in greatest need. SHN purchases the required ingredients with the funds raised and also provides the equipment required for packaging. The meals are then packaged by volunteers through an engaging assembly line process – the number of volunteers required for packaging is based on the number of meals being packaged.

The packaged meals are then distributed primarily through nutrition programs operated by partner organizations. These programs promote education, encourage children to attend school, improve the health and nutrition of students, promote gender equality and maternal health, spur economic growth, combat child labor and create a platform for tackling global issues.

Over the past 5 months, 9 meal packaging events have been conducted in Bangalore, Chennai, Mumbai & Delhi in which a total of 500,000 meals were packaged.

Nearly 1,000 boxes (216,000 meals) have been provided to nine different NGOs in Delhi, Mumbai and Bangalore who are working with children of migrant laborers, orphans, abandoned children, disabled and blind children. Some meals have also been transported to Manipur to be given to families affected by the floods. Rotary Clubs in Mumbai and Bangalore have been very active partners in coordinating distribution and management of delivery of meals.



Rural Health

Mobile Health Units

Despite the best efforts by the government to make health facilities available to its people, a large number of people particularly in rural and tribal areas remain inaccessible to even primary health care. Most of these people are children, women and the elderly. Mobile Health Units (MHU) are a vital and useful mechanism to reach out to people living in remote villages breaking geographical barriers. Most of these villages are devoid of public health facilities. At times the deprived or the marginalized are not able to seek medical help due to a variety of economic and social problems. The impact of MMUs can be gauged from the fact that the Central Govt. has accepted Mobile Medicare as a highly effective means of delivery of health services.

SACH tied up with Stop Hunger Now (SHN) and Kraft Heinz to run Mobile Medical Units in remote villages of Banka and Prakasam districts of Bihar Andhra Pradesh respectively to address routine health problems of the people. The program envisages providing approximately 25000 treatments annually.

Highlights of the programme:

- 1. Medical Consultation:** The project is providing primary health care services to the needy and in particular children, women at the chosen sites. The patients come to the MMU parking site in the location or MMU team makes home visits to the homes of those suffering from chronic diseases. The doctor physically examines patients and prescribes medicines. Wherever required, the patients are referred for detailed investigation / secondary / tertiary health care service providers for specialist treatment / care.

The MMU Team

- Medical Consultant
- Lab Technician
- Pharmacist
- Driver cum community facilitator
- Care giver



2. **Free Medicines:** The MHU stocks medicines specifically chosen for common ailments based by our medical panel as well as disease profile in the region. These medicines are issued to the patients free of cost. The pharmacist also explains the dosage of medicines, how to use them and side effects, if any to the patients.
3. **Basic Diagnostics:** The MMU is equipped with diagnostic equipments such as stethoscope, BP Aparatus, glucometer for blood sugar testing, weighing machine, otoscope for examination of the inner ear, Ophthalmoscope, thermometer, ECG and a mobile lab kit for carrying out detailed diagnostic tests like lipid profile, kidney function test and liver function test.
4. **Sensitization and training:** For care providers/volunteers in basic health care, nutrition and positive lifestyle, special educational sessions are being conducted on nutrition and preventive health; and also for beneficiaries in the maintenance of hygiene, sleep disorders, mental health, etc.
5. **Treatment data collection:** It is essential to gather basic data about the progress made and goals achieved through the intervention from the field. This helps planners as well as implementers with new strategy if required, the complexities and the quality of intervention. Similarly, it provides significant inputs for researchers to analyze the situation and needs of the community as well donor community to make decisions based on the findings of the primary research. The idea is to gather all information using our i-health Software. This information would be available to the donor for regular monitoring of the performance of MMU services.
6. **Referral services for secondary and tertiary:** The MMU team establishes linkages with Govt. and other health care providers in the vicinity to refer the secondary and tertiary care patients as well as for advanced diagnostics services. This linkage would enable better treatment for the referral cases in reduced or subsidised cost.

Health Camps

SACH has been holding regular free health camps in Bijnor (Uttar Pradesh) and GRTC (Delhi) with idea to reach out to people who can't afford to go to expensive health facilities. SACH offered free medicine and pathological tests in the camps. SACH also made case studies about the patients suffering from the chronic diseases. All these patients were treated at health camps and the MHUs visits.



Disaster Response

In November 2015, SACH sent its Mobile Health Unit (MHU) to Cuddalore district in Tamil Nadu to reach out to the flood affected people who did not have access to government medical facilities. The MHU has the regular staff comprising a doctor, physiotherapist, pharmacist, lab assistant and a team of paramedic volunteers to assist them. The initiative was supported by Stop Hunger Now (SHN) and Kraft Heinz.

Though there is no denying the fact that the government has prevented the outbreak of the any major disease following the floods, SACH's team provided treatment for common ailments aggravated by the calamity such as viral fever, cold and cough, gastroenteritis, arthritis and body pain. SACH MHU spent nine days starting December 12 after the water started to recede in the district. The team visited 11 villages and treated around 2000 people







- a. Fixed assets are stated at historical cost less depreciation.

As per the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, the assets acquired out of the grant received is treated as application of income, hence the assets purchased has been part of the income & expenditure account as expense. Depreciation has been provided as per Income Tax Act, 1961 on the face of balance sheet.

V. INVESTMENTS

- a. There is no long term Investments at the year end.

VI. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTIONS

- a. Foreign currencies transactions are recorded on initial recognition in the reporting currency by applying to the foreign currency amount the exchange rate prevailing at the date of transaction on the grant received.
